### **Scholarship Background**

In 2001, The Hong Kong Association of Northern California (HKANC) initiated a Scholarship fund designed to provide scholarships to undergraduate and graduate university students of high academic distinction. This is based on the belief that investing in today's youth will help to ensure that students strive to achieve their goals and to develop into leaders of tomorrow. As of to date, more than \$435,000 in scholarship funds have been donated to the community colleges and universities in Northern California for deserving students of outstanding community involvement and academic achievement with financial needs.

## **Eligibility and Selection Criteria**

- 1. U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, **OR** International Student,
- MUST be currently enrolled in an Undergraduate (Full-time: 12 units) OR Graduate (Half-time: 6 units) program in a 2- OR 4-year college or university located in Northern California,
- 3. Any majors with a GPA of 3.5 or above,
- Volunteered at least one major fundraising event and general event OR participated in other available volunteer projects AND joined HKANC free student membership (preferred),
- Demonstrated fluency in Chinese AND English. (verbal required, verbal & written preferred)
- 6. Must provide completed scholarship application form and required documents.
